

## Make your own Whitby Witch Badges


With an adults help carefully follow the instructions below to make your own Whitby Witch Badges.

### Ingredients for salt dough badges:

- 1 Cup of Flour (8oz/225g) ½ Cup of Salt (4oz/112g) ½ Cup of Cold Water (4floz/100ml)

#### **Instructions:**

- 1. Mix the flour, salt and water together until you form a dough. You are aiming for a pastry-like consistency that won't stick to the rolling pin, so add extra flour if you need it.
- 2. Sprinkle some flour on the work surface, and roll out the dough to a thickness of about 4mm to 5mm
- 3. Using the designs on the page as a guide start creating your own Whitby Wiches badges!
- 4. Once ready, place the badges on a non-stick oven tray and bake on a low heat for 3 hours. Keep it low: Gas Mark 3 / 160c
- 5. Remove from the oven and leave too cool. Alternatively, leave the badges out, and they will be dry within a few days.
- 6. Once cool you can decorate the badges however you like!
